Areas covered by grants (parliamentary constituency)

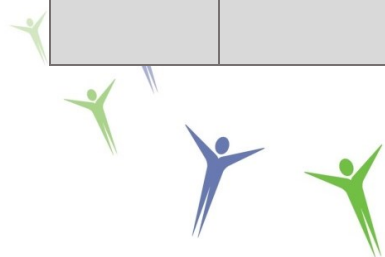
